

1. Create a new folder, for example **C:\Driver**; use this as the driver download destination.
2. Double-click file to decompress it.
3. Copy the files into the new folder which you have just created.
4. Plug the Swift USB Drive into any free USB port on your computer, or into a USB hub connected to your computer; the **Add New Hardware** wizard window will appear.
5. Select **“Search for the best driver for your device”** option, then click the **Next>** button.
6. Select **“Specify a location:”** click the button. Locate and select the Driver folder (example).
7. Click the **Next>** button until the software installation is complete.
8. Repeat steps 5-8.
9. You may now use the Swift USB Drive with your computer.
